Embracing the dark to reimagine how we live, resist, and create together. Welcome to the Abyss where darkness is not absence — it is a beginning. From silence and pressure, luminous possibilities emerge.

HELLO, DARKNESS

WE WILL DESIGN 2026
ATMOSPHERE

In times marked by hyper-exposure and individualism, darkness returns as a sign of our present: obscurantism, perturbation, invisibilized communities, and the sense of a world on the edge of collapse. **HELLO DARKNESS** invites us to acknowledge the abyss — political, ecological, aesthetic — facing it not only as a place of fear, but above all as a space of regeneration, resistance, and imagination. Darkness here is not absence, but a fertile condition: a teacher, an ally, a landscape where unexpected forms of life, knowledge, and relationships emerge.

It is both disturbing and fertile — a metaphor for the shadows of our present, where uncertainty dominates and voices are silenced, yet where seeds of resistance and renewal can take root.

Drawing inspiration from extreme ecologies and from Black feminist thought — in particular Alexis Pauline Gumbs' *Undrowned: Black Feminist Lessons from Marine Mammals* — **HELLO DARKNESS** challenges us to find ways of breathing, coexisting, and imagining futures in the midst of pressure, trauma, and systemic violence.

At BASE, darkness becomes a field of possibility: a porous infrastructure that welcomes invisible gestures, marginalized knowledges, and luminous resistances. **It is a call to design new ways of inhabiting the present, building alternative communities, envisioning unexpected futures, and revealing the hidden systems that sustain collective life.**

HELLO DARKNESS

opens up a space where design becomes a tool to overturn hierarchies, weave together ecologies and technologies, and imagine cities and societies yet to come.

FOUR TRAJECTORIES GUIDE THIS EXPLORATION:

Inhabiting the Uninhabitable

Strategies for adapting and creating in hostile or unstable environments. Not just a response to crisis, but an invitation to imagine new ways of living and inhabiting the present under conditions of pressure and uncertainty.

Underground Practices

Radical processes that dismantle existing orders and nurture countercultures. Darkness becomes a space where alternative communities and forms of coexistence can emerge, challenging dominant systems and hierarchies.

Prophecies

Speculative visions that question the future and its possibilities. These trajectories are not escapes from reality but imaginative exercises that open space for unexpected narratives and critical reflections on what is to come.

Invisible Architectures

A focus on the submerged systems that sustain collective life yet often remain unseen. Design here becomes a tool to reveal and reimagine the hidden infrastructures that support our societies.

DESIGN AMBASSADORS

To shape the 2026 edition of We Will Design, three Italian designers and curators have been invited to guide the selection of the participating projects. Their role is not only to evaluate, but to open perspectives, recognize resonances, and identify practices that embody the spirit of HELLO DARKNESS.

With their diverse backgrounds and sensibilities, they will accompany the program as critical voices and cultural practitioners, helping to weave together the trajectories of research, experimentation, and collective imagination that define this year's framework.

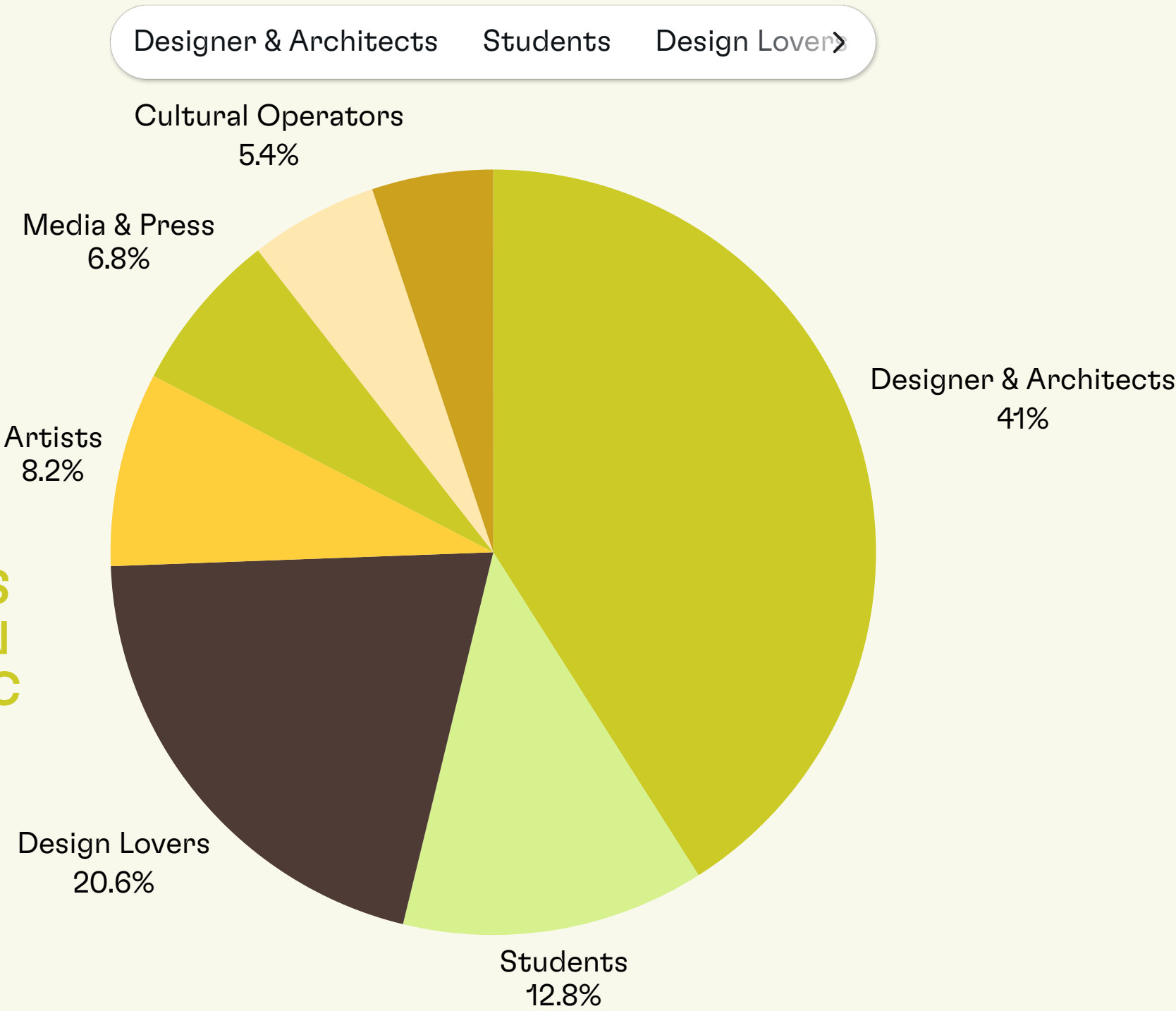

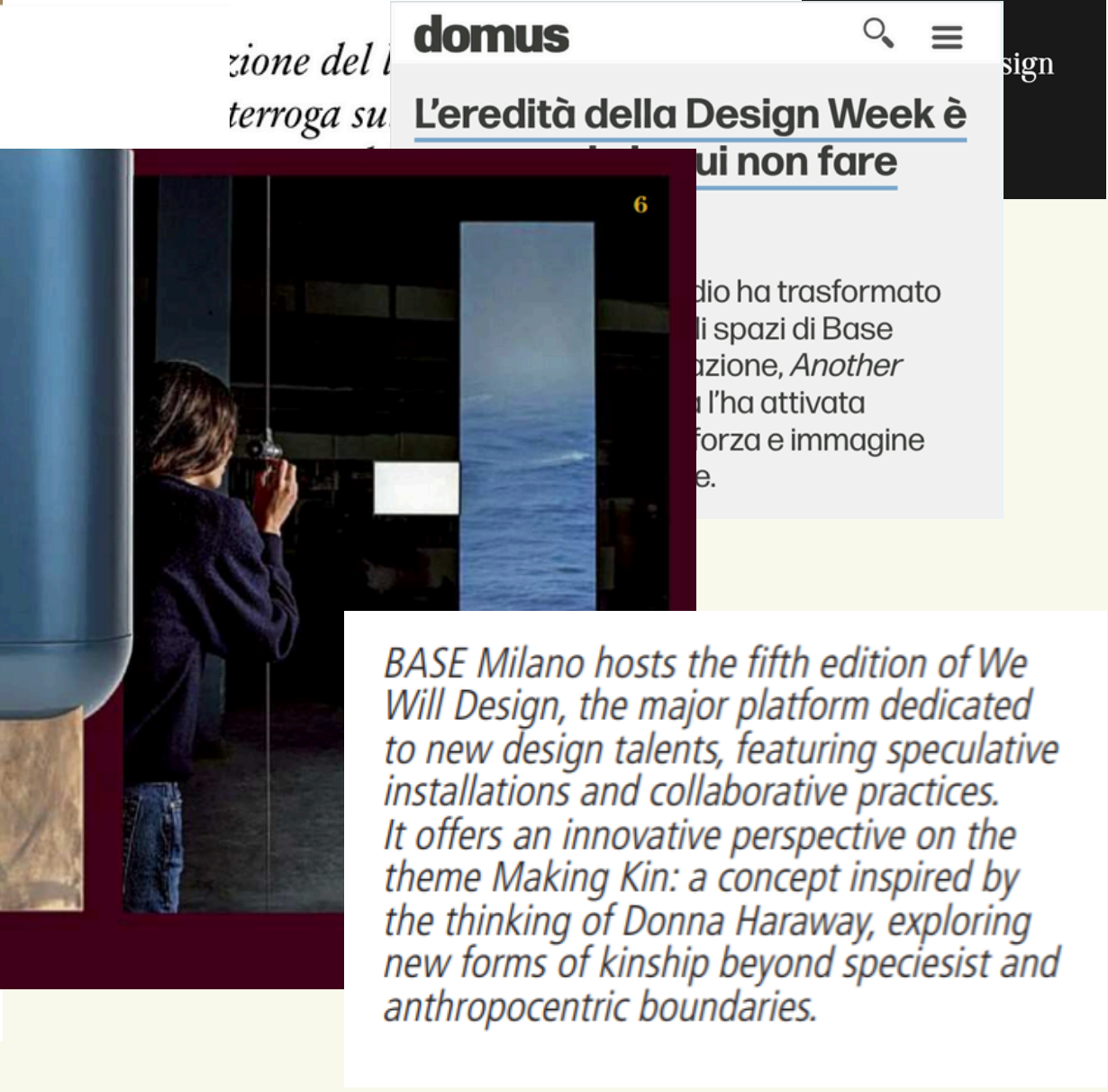
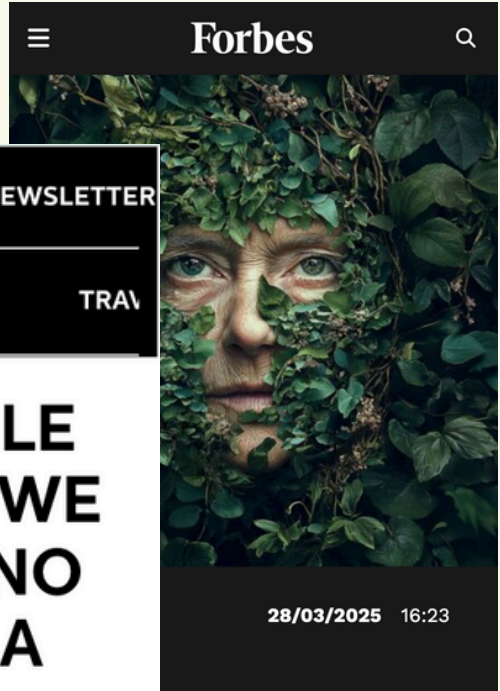
